Postdoc Position in Ecology (75 %)

A postdoc position is available in the division of Community Ecology at the University of Bern.

Requirements

The candidate must have received a Ph.D. in biology with emphasis in ecology within the last years. She/he should be interested in independent research in ecology. Possible fields of interest are: ecological aspects of invertebrates, arthropod-plant-relationships including biochemical aspects, soil ecology, pollination ecology, biological control, alien and invasive species. Other topics are possible provided they complement existing research in our group. The successful candidate is expected to develop into an independent position with her/his own funding. Experience in teaching and specific knowledge of an arthropod group is advantageous.
